In 1904, Canada's very first train robbery was perpetrated by the infamous Bill Miner, who also coined the phrase "Hands Up!" Mr. Miner and his two accomplices were apprehended by the Northwest Mounted Police in 1905. Frederick Fulton, a local Kamloops lawyer, and B.C.'s Attorney General, prosecuted and convicted Mr. Miner who was subsequently sentenced to twenty five years in prison.
